APFEI aims to provide a platform for educators from a range of sectors, disciplines and nations to investigate, collaborate, share resources and develop projects in the field of educational integrity. Via interactive and inclusive dialogue with conference delegates, this workshop will provide an opportunity for this aim to be realised and extended, particularly in relation to international partnerships.
